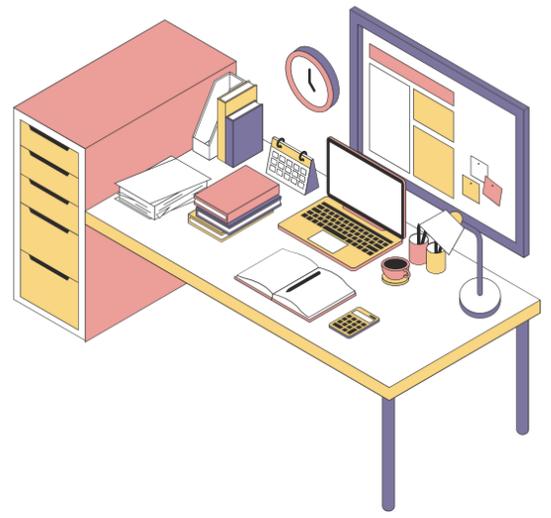


5 Ways to Support Your Teen's Online Learning Journey

You can help to ensure their study area is stocked with necessary supplies like notebooks, pens and reliable Wi-Fi.

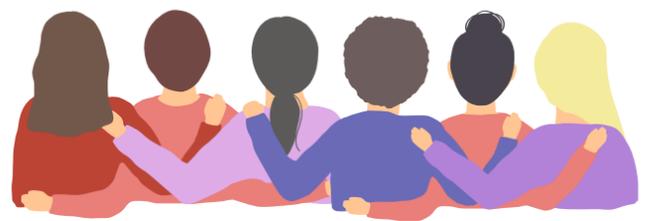


2 Encourage Goal Setting and Time Management
